Your Ancestors

The Family Tree

This booklet provides a family tree in the centre (pages 20-21). Every entry on the centre page will correspond to a matching Ancestor Profile.

A family tree is a chart that displays how your ancestors are all connected.

Record an individual's name, birth year and death year (if applicable) in each box. Make sure to record a woman's maiden surname, not married name.

Ancestor Profiles

In this booklet you will find all ancestor profiles relating to a member of your family tree. Female ancestors will be located on the right page, with male ancestors on the left page. Their relation to you will be noted on the profile.

Ancestor profiles of your paternal side (father's family) are from pages 19 backwards to page 4.

For your maternal side (mother's family) they are from page 22 forwards to page 37.

These ancestor profiles have been designed to work in conjunction with your family tree (middle of this booklet), the number of each profile matches the number provided in the tree.

These profiles are to provide you space to gather all the relevant information of each ancestor together in this booklet. There is space to input information from birth, marriage, death and census records. Additionally, you can input siblings, children and additional information in each profile.

There are notes pages available at the end of this book for any additional information.

You can view an example ancestor profile on the final page.
